

The 1,800-sq.-ft. addition was inspired by the spare, iconic profile of a classic barn. Its height is exaggerated by the vertical lines in the black-stained Accoya wood siding. To keep the roofline clean and strong, the eaves were hidden on the sides, and the concrete patio echoes the shape and industrial simplicity of the windows. A single red window frame is an arresting accent.
